## TOWN OF SHERMAN BUDGET HEARING NOVEMBER 15, 2018

Daniel J. Fedderly, Chairman, called the Town of Sherman Public Budget Hearing to order at 5:30 p.m. on November 15, 2018 at the Sherman Town Hall.

Chairman Daniel J. Fedderly, Board Members, Charles Maves, Daniel Debee, Paul Wathke, Kelley Krause, and Clerk/Treasurer, Ashley Score, were present.

Daniel stated the Public Budget Hearing had been published in the Dunn County News and posted correctly per statue. The proposed budget was made available to the public to review prior to the meeting. Daniel asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the proposed budget. There were none.

Motion to approve 2017 budget planning meeting minutes made by Charles, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dan. Motion passed.

Motion to approve the 2017 budget hearing minutes made by Charles, 2<sup>nd</sup> Paul. Motion passed.

Ashley noted she received an updated assessment from Boyceville Fire that day, and provided the updated budget to reflect the assessment change. Discussion on the assessment decrease and ramifications if the truck payment is billed in 2019 instead of added to the 2020 budget planning and the possibility of not being able to recover already expended funds outside the allowable levy limit in the next fiscal/tax year.

Dan made the motion to keep compensation for Chairman, Supervisor #1, and Supervisor #2 the same as previous years, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kelley. Motion passed.

Motion to approve and adopt 2019 budget at proposed with noted updates by Charles, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kelley, motion passed.
