O-01-2002



THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board for the Town of Sherman, Dunn County, at their regular board meeting held on March 7, 2002, will consider passing a pocket gopher ordinance, due to the Wisconsin State Statues Sec. 66.37 being repealed, thus through Village Powers granted to the Town Board by Resolution 01-2001, passed on August 27, 2001, the Town Board of Sherman hereby declares that the Town of Sherman, Dunn County, will pay \$1.75 for all gopher tails presented to the Town Clerk.


