ORDINANCE # 03-2000

**ORDINANCE RELATING TO CHARGING
PROPERTY OWNERS FOR FIRE CALLS**

WHEREAS, the Town Board must provide for fire protection for the Town, pursuant to Section 60.55(1), Statutes and

WHEREAS, the Town Board is authorized by Section 60.55(2), Statutes, to fund the provision of fire protection by charging property owners a fee for the cost of fire calls made to their property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Town of Sherman, Dunn County, Wisconsin, ordains as follows:


Section 1. Owners of real or personal property shall pay the actual cost billed to the Town for fire calls.


Section 2. The Town Clerk shall mail a statement for the full charge(s) to the owner of the property for which a fire call was made as soon after the fire call as practicable. Unless the fee is paid to the Town Treasurer within ninety days after the day the statement was sent by the Clerk, interest shall accrue on the unpaid balance at the rate of 1.5 % per month from the date of the original billing. Fire call fees remaining unpaid at the end of the year shall be collected in any manner authorized by law.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.


