Amending the 2022 Budget

Adopted by the

A resolution changing the 2022 budget of the Town of Sherman, Dunn County,

Wisconsin, adopted by a two-thirds majority vote of the entire membership of the Town Board.

That year-to-date, the Public Works Account will increase \$78,000.00 from \$120,000.00 to \$198,000.00.

That year-to-date, the Public Safety Account will increase \$2,658.23 from \$72,641.77 to \$75,300.00.

That year-to-date, the Health and Human Services Account will increase \$2,600.00 from \$75,450.08 to \$78,050.08.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Sherman as follows:


That the sum of \$78,000.00 is hereby transferred from the Capital Improvement Account to the Public Works Expense Account,

That the sum \$2,658.23 is hereby transferred from the Carry Over Account to the Public Safety Account.

That the sum of \$2,600.00 is hereby transferred from the Carry Over Account to the Health and Human Services Account.
